Hill n Dale Children's Ministry- Minors' Guidelines

These guidelines apply to all individuals who work as minors with children at Hill n Dale Christian Church.

1. One must have been a member or regular attender of Hill n Dale Christian Church for at least six (6) months to be eligible to apply to work with children.
2. No persons who have been convicted of child/youth abuse will be permitted to work in any capacity in a church-sponsored activity for children.
3. Minors working with children must always have at least one adult working with them at all times. Exceptions to this *must* be approved by the children's minister.
4. Minors who have not been approved to work with children are not allowed to be in children's ministry rooms with children. This includes friends of minors currently working.
5. Minors serving in HnD's children's ministry will show respect for the adults, other youth, and children in the children's ministry. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Being on time
 - b. Being respectful in speech
 - c. Being respectful in actions

The children look up to the youth volunteers as faith-filled role models.
6. Minors serving in HnD's children's ministry will show respect for the facility and church property. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Eating and drinking at designated times, in designated areas only. This means no eating or drinking in classrooms, unless during a designated snack time.
 - b. Keeping out of areas of the church building not designated for your use.
 - c. Keeping all electronic equipment at home or put away (includes cell phones, games, etc.)
7. Minors serving in HnD's children's ministry will show respect for themselves, the youth volunteer. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Providing an environment conducive to service to the children of our congregation.
 - b. Providing supervision and a positive example as you help others learn about our faith.

Possible consequences

Procedures for youth volunteers exhibiting behavior problems include:

Discussion with adult supervisor

Discussion with children's minister or other minister

Parent phone call

Parent phone call with request that youth is immediately picked up

Suspension from serving in HnD's children's ministry
